Next term we will be delivering our RSE (Relationship and Sexuality Programme) to all 2nd and 3rd year students. Our SPHE (Social Personal & Health Education) teachers will be using a program called the 'Active Consent for School Communities Program'. This program shares knowledge and skills that enable young people to practice active agency with regards their sexual health: https://www.consenthub.ie/
