This term we are delivering our Relationships & Sexuality (RSE) program to Transition Year students.

We are delighted to have secured a place on the 'Debunking the Myths' workshop facilitated by the Science Foundation of Ireland.

The workshop will take place online in school 1pm to 3pm on December 12th. It is an online interactive program so all students will be participating in school. Students will be using their mobile phones during this workshop so ensure your students bring their phone to school that day.

Four experts (clinicians from Beaumont Hospital, Rotunda Hospital, and the Royal College of Surgeons) cover topics such as Contraception, STIs, Sex positivity etc. It is entirely interactive with panellists from all hospitals available to answer questions in real time.
